10. [LRB] Circle K Atl #185 (new business), Malik Dhanani (with Dana Farkis), 350 Moreland Ave, Convenience Store / Distance waiver. L5PBA motion to **support**, **passed** 9-0-0
11. [ZRB] Z-18-84 / 881 Ponce de Leon Ave NE [PHNA] / An Ordinance designating the Ponce de Leon Tourist Home, located at 881 Ponce de Leon Avenue, NE, Land Lot 16 of the 14th District of Fulton County, Georgia and certain real property on which it is located, to the overlay zoning designation of Landmark Building or Site pursuant to Chapter 20 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Atlanta and rezoning from MRC-2-C/Beltline to MRC-2-C/Beltline/Landmark building or site; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes. [BZA] V-18-199 / 828 Ralph McGill [PHNA] / Applicant Ryan Gravel seeks a special exception from the zoning regulation to 1) reduce the required parking from 94 parking spaces to 3 parking space, and 2) reduce the required loading space from 1 loading space to 0. CHANGE: City requested reconciliation of numbers for Telephone Factory as a whole; 238 parking spaces to 100 spaces, 4 loading spaces to 1. IPNA motion to **support, passed** 9-0-0.
13. L5PCAC rep was excused.
14. V-18-231 / 312 North Highland Avenue NE [IPNA] / Applicant seeks a special exception from the zoning ordinance to reduce the required on-site parking from 41 parking spaces to 11 parking spaces. IPNA motion to **support, passed** 8-0-0.
15. L5PCAC rep returned.
16. Z-18-57 / 971 Wylie Street SE [RCIL] / Motion to **not support** because applicant did not appear, **passed**. 9-0-0.
17. Z-18-83 / An Ordinance to amend the 1982 Atlanta Zoning Ordinance, as amended, City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances part 16, so as to add a new Chapter 16A entitled I-Mix (Industrial Mixed-Use) District; to define certain areas and for other purposes. Members requested clarification on the ordinance, prior to September vote.
18. Old Business – Moreland LCI process slowed down. Development on Highland Ave denied re-zoning application, with suit filed.
19. New Business – Members requested clarification on minutes.
20. Imagine Memorial LCI process beginning in September.
