- 2. Motion to approve May 2019 minutes, passed 8-0-0

- 5. MARTA / Columbia Ventures presented plans for a parking garage at the Candler Park station.
- 6. IPNA representative arrived.
- 7. Planner's Report: Kemberli Sargent announced share-scooter speed cap on Beltline.
- 8. Center for Civic Innovation announced a citywide review of NPU practices.
- 9. [LRB] Rita's Kitchen, Tal Postelnik Baum, 699 Ponce de Leon Avenue. PHNA motion to approve, passed 9-0-0.
- 10. [MOSE] Forward Warrior / September 14<sup>th</sup>, Wylie Street. RCIL motion to approve, passed 8-0-1 (1 abstention / CNIA recused to present application).
- 11. [MOSE] Sunday in the Park (Oakland Cemetery). Applicant did not appear.
- 12. [BZA] V-19-131, 601 Clifton [LCN] Applicant seeks a variance from the zoning regulation to reduce the required rear yard setback from 15 feet to 3 feet for the construction of a two-story accessory structure. LCN motion to support, passed 9-0-0.
- 13. [BZA] V-19-135, 995 Wylie Street SE [RCIL] Applicant seeks a variance from the zoning regulations to 1) reduce the required east side yard setback from 7 feet to 3 feet and 2) exceed the maximum height of a building from 35 feet to 40 feet, to construct a new duplex. Deferred.
- 14. Old business: Board members discussed the Fast Track review process. Motion to move adopt the procedure passed 8-0-1
